<p><b>DETAILS:</b> On 9/24/13, the Loveland Police Department received an email outlining child abuse allegations that occurred within the city limits of Loveland over the last several months. The complainant alleged that Jeremy Yachik, a 35 year-old Loveland resident, had physically abused a juvenile.</p> <p>The Loveland Police Department conducted an investigation about those allegations. On October 22, 2013, Loveland Police Department investigators sought and were granted an arrest warrant for Jeremy. On October 23, 2013, Jeremy was arrested at his Loveland home without incident. Jeremy was taken to the Loveland Police Department. He posted bond and was released.</p> <p>The warrant alleges the following charges:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 18-6-401(7)(a)(V) Child Abuse [4 counts]. Class 1 Misdemeanors</li><li>• 18-3-303 False Imprisonment [1 count]. A Class 2 Misdemeanor</li></ul> <p>The Loveland Police Department is unable to comment about this investigation.</p> <p>A booking photograph of Jeremy is attached with the press release.</p> <p>The case has been turned over to the District Attorney's office. Please contact them for any future questions.</p> <p>*The criminal charges are only allegations and the defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.</p>
