<b>DETAILS:</b> <p>On June 16, 2011, at approximately 1:46 a.m., the Loveland Police Department received simultaneous calls in reference to a possible in-progress burglary at the Good Day Pharmacy located at 2033 N. Boise Avenue, Loveland. The alarm company which services the business reported a burglary alarm indicating there was movement inside the business. At the same time, an area resident reported hearing a loud noise and glass breaking.</p> <p>The first responding officers arrived on scene within 2 minutes of the call being dispatched. Officers found a broken window on the north side of the business and confirmed entry had been made. A large amount of controlled substances and pharmaceuticals were taken. The suspects fled the area prior to the officers' arrival.</p> <p>Using information obtained by the Fort Collins Police Services' (F.C.P.S) Criminal Investigations Unit and the Northern Colorado Drug Task Force (N.C.D.T.F), investigators quickly found a possible location for the suspects and stolen pharmaceuticals.</p> <p>At approximately 5:30 p.m. that same day, the F.C.P.S S.W.A.T Team executed a search warrant in the 2700 block of Meadowlark Avenue in Fort Collins. Evidence linking two suspects to the burglary and theft was located. Two suspects were arrested and are identified as 30 year old Jason Alan Beezley and 20 year old Lena Sheehan, both of Fort Collins. Both suspects were booked into the Larimer County Detention center on 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Burglary and Theft charges.</p> <p>The Loveland Police Department would like to extend a special note of thanks to the Fort Collins Police Services and the Northern Colorado Drug Task Force for their help in this investigation. Their assistance was vital to the safe and timely identification and apprehension of the suspects.</p> <p>No photos of the suspects will be released at this time as the investigation is ongoing.
