DETAILS: <p>At 6:48 a.m. this morning, Loveland Police Officers responded to a report of a suicidal person at a residence in the 3000 block of Sedgwick Court. Officers arrived on scene within four minutes of receiving the call and established a containment perimeter around the residence.</p> <p>Officers received information a 41 year old male was alone inside the residence and threatened to harm himself with a handgun. At 6:57 a.m., officers requested an Everbridge phone notification to residents in the immediate area to notify them of the incident and request they stay in their homes for their safety until the incident could be resolved.</p> <p>The man refused to surrender to officers and at 7:23 a.m. the Loveland Police S.W.A.T. Team responded to assist. S.W.A.T. Crisis Negotiators initiated a dialogue with the man, and at 7:54 a.m. he surrendered to officers and was taken into protective custody without incident. Officers subsequently recovered a handgun from inside the residence.</p> <p>There were no shots fired and no one was injured during the incident. The Loveland Police Department does not anticipate any charges will be filed in connection with the incident.</p> <p>*The criminal charges are only allegations and the defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty at trial.</p>
