<p>On 010912 at approximately 1200 hours, Loveland Police Department officers were notified of a missing Loveland man. Dylan Degrazio called to report that his father, George Degrazio had left his home to run some errands and did not return. George was driving his 2010, red Nissan Xterra.</p> <p>On 011112 at approximately 0436 hours, Fort Collins Police Officers located George's vehicle in a business center parking lot at 4721 S. Timberline Dr. in the City of Fort Collins. Officers were unable to locate George or any evidence of his current status or location.</p> <p>George Degrazio is in need of daily medication.</p> <p>At this time investigators do not suspect foul play.</p> <p>George is sixty-six years old and described as 6'0" and approximately 200 pounds with graying brown hair, and blue eyes. George may have a full beard. See accompanying photo.</p> <p>It is very important that if George hears any broadcast of his disappearance that he call his son immediately about a family emergency.
