REQUEST FOR OPEN BURNING PERMITS

The process for obtaining Open Burning Permits within the Loveland Fire Protection District now has three options including a "***no fee option***".

The three options are:

1. An on-line application (qualifies for the "***no fee option***" if photos are attached)
2. A paper application that you mail in
3. Call the Loveland Fire Prevention Bureau and we will fill one out for you. (Gather your pertinent information and call **962-2534**).

The "***no fee option***" will not apply to applications that are called in or mailed in. For those applications, a **\$30 fee** is required for a site inspection.

Step one:

Go directly to the webpage at <http://www.larimer.org/burnpermit/>

Or... the Larimer County website at <http://www.larimer.org> and type the words BURN PERMIT in the search box. The link for the correct page will be provided.

Step two:

Read the guidelines. Go to the box called APPLY FOR OPEN BURNING PERMIT and select an application option.

Step three:

If you complete the paper application as directed and mail to the address shown on website, **your permit will be mailed to you** (upon approval).

Or... Complete the electronic application as directed. Attach digital photo(s) of the slash pile. If no photos are attached, you may be charged \$30 for a site inspection. **Your PDF-version permit will be e-mailed to you** (upon approval).

Remember: Slash pile burning within the City of Loveland is not allowed.

Notice: All burning regulations must be followed at all times or the permit will be revoked and a fine may be assessed to the applicant.
